SMALL GROUPS

Discussion questions for Week 2 of 1st Peter (1st Peter 1:10-21)

Reread 1 Peter 1:10-12. What stands out to you about the prophets' search to understand God's salvation and the angels' desire to look into it? What does this teach us about the privilege of living after the death and resurrection of Jesus?

Reread 1 Peter 1:13-16. Peter moves from describing salvation to calling for holy living. Brainstorm the close connection between these two ideas. Identify each piece of specific advice he gives here, and discuss why he mentions each.

Reread 1 Peter 1:17-21. Peter reminds believers that the Father judges, that they were redeemed not with silver or gold but with the precious blood of Christ, and where their faith and hope should rest. How should each of these affect the way you view God, yourself, and your daily choices?
